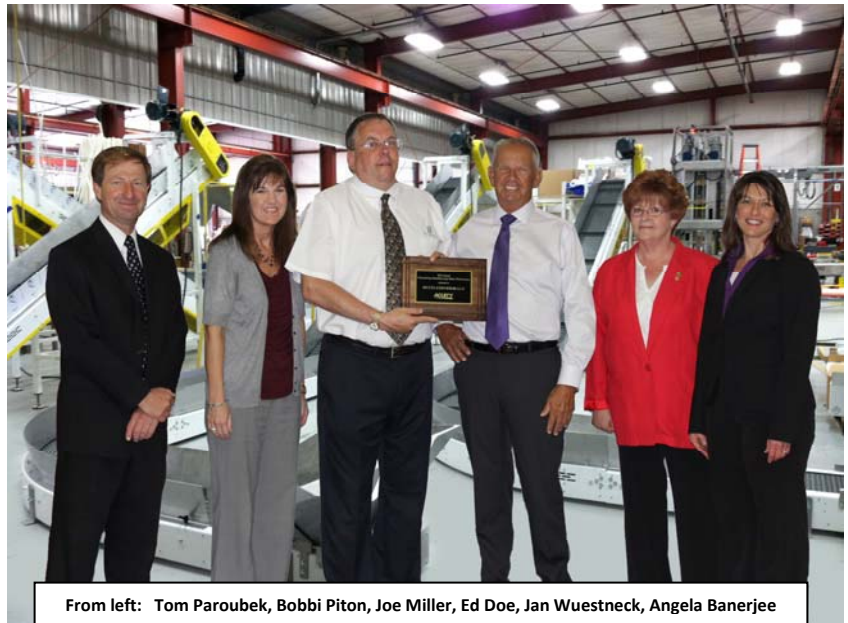
### Multi-Conveyor LLC Receives *ACUITY* Safety Achievement Award
